What can you expect as a PSA Intern?

An internship at our operations department would provide you with an excellent opportunity to gain an understanding of Vessel Operations Procedures.

- Monitoring, vessel's schedule for berthing arrangement at Port of call.
- Act as an agent for in/out of vessels – declaring/liasing with government agencies such as LPK, Customs, ORGA, AELB, etc.
- Understanding of discharging and load list for vessel planner allocation
- Act as an agent; maintaining stowage plan, crane split – liaising with terminal and principal.
- Monitoring special units (DG segregation, RF, OOG, special stow units, etc).
- Liaising with vessel command and principal for any special arrangement such as crew change, FW supply, FO supply, etc.
- Upon vessel departure – update in LMS/Opus, provide TOR/TDR/EDI.
- Update SDR (LMS) if any damage been reported. Liaising with terminal for claims purposes.
